Whereas a special town meeting of the town electors has been called and properly noticed to consider a resolution to authorize an addition to the Calumet Fire Department located at W3118 County Road W, Malone, WI;

Whereas, the town electors, after proper notice, have, via a *special town meeting* vote, authorized the Town of Calumet to proceed with constructing an addition.

Therefore, be it resolved that we, the town electors of the Town of Calumet, being duly assembled at the special town meeting on November 9, 2022, do hereby authorize the Town Board of the Town of Calumet to construct an addition to the Fire Station located at W3118 County Rd W, Malone, WI 53049 pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes Sec. 60.10(2)(f)

**RESOLUTION OF TOWN ELECTORS TO ADOPT THE TOTAL TOWN TAX LEVY
AT SPECIAL TOWN MEETING OF TOWN ELECTORS**

**Town of Calumet, Fond du Lac County
Resolution No. 221111**

Whereas Wis. Stat. § 60.10(1)(a) authorizes the town electors of a town to adopt the town tax levy at a town meeting of the electors;

Whereas a special town meeting of the town electors has been called and properly noticed to approve the 2022 total town tax levy (to be collected in 2023), pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 60.10(1)(a);

Whereas, the town electors, after proper notice, have, via a *special town meeting* vote, authorized the Town of Calumet to exceed the allowable state levy limit.

THEREFORE, the special town meeting of the Town of Calumet, Fond du Lac County, Wisconsin, by a majority vote of the eligible electors duly assembled and voting on this 9th day of November 2022, hereby resolves and orders as follows:


1. The town electors of the Town of Calumet, Fond du Lac County, Wisconsin adopt the total town tax levy for 2022 (to be collected in 2023) in the amount of **\$583,952**.
2. The town clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required by law under Wis. Stat. § 60.80(1)(a) within 30 days after its adoption.



RESOLUTION TO EXCEED THE LEVY LIMIT

Town of Calumet, Fond du Lac County Resolution No. 221110

Whereas, the State of Wisconsin has imposed levy limits on town tax levies for 2022 and thereafter under Wis. Stat. § 66.0602.

Whereas Wis. Stat. § 66.0602(5) allows the town electors in a town with a population of less than 3,000 to exceed the maximum allowable levy limit by adoption of a resolution at a town meeting of the town electors.

Whereas the town board has adopted a resolution supporting an increase in the town tax levy which would exceed the maximum allowable state levy limit for the Town of Calumet.

Whereas a special town meeting of the town electors has been called and properly noticed to consider the adoption of a resolution to endorse a town board resolution to exceed the state levy limits, specifically by increasing the allowable town tax levy for 2022 (to be collected in 2023) by 4.473%;

THEREFORE, the special town meeting of the Town of Calumet, Fond du Lac, Wisconsin, by a majority vote of the eligible electors duly assembled and voting on this 9th day of November 2022, hereby resolves and orders as follows:

1. The town electors of the Town of Calumet, Fond du Lac County, Wisconsin endorse the town board resolution to increase the town tax levy for 2022 (to be collected in 2023) by 4.473% over the allowable 2022 levy, which is a dollar increase of \$25,000 over the allowable 2022 town tax levy.
2. The town clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required by law under Wis. Stat. § 60.80(1)(a) within 30 days after its adoption.
