Since 2019, I've proudly served as your Town Board Chairperson, guided by the promise "**Working for Everyone.**" Thank you for trusting me with this role.

You spoke, we acted.

Roads:

- **Identified** 22 miles of roads in disrepair—a serious safety and financial risk.
- **Rebuilt** 18 of those 22 miles in 6 years including our 2025 projects on St Paul, Weber, and Nett Roads.
- **Secured** \$3 million in state grants to fund the work.

Internet:

- **Partnered** with Fond du Lac County and Bug Tussel to bring high-speed internet to underserved areas in our community.
- **Leveraged** a \$290,000 FDL county grant and a \$400,000 state grant.
- **Connected** over 200 homes, businesses, and the Holyland Catholic School.

Looking ahead, my focus is clear:

- **Complete** the remaining road projects and secure grants to offset the costs.
- **Protect** our investments by transitioning rebuilt roads into an ongoing maintenance program.
- **Collaborate** with the Town Board and Plan Commission to update our Comprehensive Plan.
- **Achieve** all this within our current funding framework.

On April 1st, I'm asking for your vote to continue this progress. Together, we've made our community stronger—let's keep the momentum going.
