Owners Covenant

- Any grading, special ditching, alterations of slopes, or any other disturbance of any portion of the road right-of-way shall be restored by and at the expense of the applicant, to the condition existing prior to such disturbance and to the satisfaction to the Town of Calumet. If the restoration work or any damage caused to the road right-of-way by the applicant cannot or will not be accomplished voluntarily, the Town authority may complete the required work at the applicant's expense.
- The entire cost of the driveway construction or Installation shall be the obligation of the applicant.
- The applicant shall keep the driveway culvert free of debris and other obstructions, allowing proper drainage along roadway.
- The driveway approach shall match the edge of the shoulder grade. Approaches and driveways in the road right of way shall not slope to the existing edge of the traveled roadway.

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- e. Maintenance and upkeep of approaches, driveways and driveway culverts In the Town Road right-of-way shall be the responsibility of the applicant.
- f. The driveway(s) and culvert authorized by this permit shall be installed within a period of ninety (90) days from the issuance of said permit.
- g. The permittee, their successors, or assignees, agree to hold harmless Town of Calumet and its duly appointed agents and employees against any actions for personal injury or property damage sustained by the reasons of the issuance of this permit.
- h. All driveway/culvert installations must comply with Town of Calumet Zoning Ordinance Section 3.14.12 in its entirety. End walls are required on all private culvert installations.
- i. All road access permits applications including the size and length of all culvert installations require approval by the Town of Calumet Town Board.
- j. All culverts should be constructed using either galvanized steel or reinforced concrete, shall be of new manufacture. End walls are required on all culvert installations.
- k. Installation of additional rip rap, within the right of way for the purpose of erosion control, at a newly installed culvert will be at the discretion of the Town of Calumet Road Superintendent.
- l. Concrete driveway will not be allowed within 10 feet of a road surface. Gravel or paved asphalt only.

*** ALL PLACED CULVERTS MUST BE INSPECTED BY ROAD SUPERINTENDENT BEFORE BEING COVERED.
PLEASE SCHEDULE INSPECTION ACCORDINGLY.**
